Unaffiliated Showjumping Rules

- 1.All classes will be run as Single Phase (those horse and rider combinations going clear will be entered into a separate jump off). In the absence of any clear rounds, placings will be decided on combinations with the least number of faults in the quickest times.
- 2. Riders may commence their show jumping round once the judge has rung the bell.
- 3. Faults will be awarded as follows:

Knockdown 4 faults 1st Refusal 4 faults 2nd Refusal 8 faults

3rd Refusal Elimination Error of course Elimination Fall of rider Elimination

- 4. Those combinations eliminated are permitted to jump one fence before leaving the ring. In the case of a fall, the rider must wait to be assessed by the First Aider in attendance before leaving the arena on foot. Under no circumstances shall a rider remount their horse whilst still in the arena
- 5. Rosettes for those placed 1st 6th in all classes.
- 6. Trophies awarded to those attaining a 1st place in all the Championship classes.
- 7. In the interest of welfare of the horse, a competitor will be disqualified if the horse is lame, sick or exhausted, in the opinion of the judge. Any misuse of whip, spurs or bit will also result in disqualification.
- 8. Whips should be between 45cm and 75cm long.
- 9. In the interest of welfare, no horse/pony shall compete in more than three classes.
- 10. In the warm-up arena, the practice fence should be no higher than the class in progress.
- 11. BSJA combinations are welcome to enter HC.
- 12. Overall 2023 Season Championship Trophy will be awarded on a points accumulation system. This trophy is awarded at our presentation evening with an overall Championship rosette.



Unaffiliated Dressage Rules

- 1. This season is for unaffiliated riders, however affiliated competitors not above BD Group 6 and combinations that have not won more than 50 BD points in the current year can compete in Novice and Elementary. Please make note of this in your online entry.
- 2. The event will be run under British Dressage Rules which can be found on their website.
- 3. Only pre-entries will be accepted and valid.
- 4. A £2 late entry fee is applied to entries accepted after the closing date.
- 5. Trophies awarded to those attaining a 1st place in all the Championship classes including the Lead Rein Class and ROR Sections.
- 6. Overall 2023 Season Championship Trophy will be awarded on a points accumulation system. This trophy is awarded at our presentation evening on December 2nd 2023 with an overall Championship rosette.
- 7. The dressage league will run separately and also be done on a points accumulation system.
- 8. The ROR section will run throughout the season in levels Unaffiliated Intro and Unaffiliated Prelim (excluding GFP League). This will be judged and placed separately.
- 9. Callers are permitted Intro Elementary. GFP can provide a caller on the day for levels Intro Novice. If you require a caller for Elementary level, we ask that you bring your own.

In Hand & Ridden Showing Rules

- 1. All ridden animals must be four years old and over. The age of an animal shall be calculated from the 1st January in the year of its birth.
- 2. No animal or rider may leave the ring without permission of the Judge and Ring Steward. Once a class has commenced there shall be no change of rider or handler.
- 3. A fall of animal or rider whilst mounted in any class will result in disqualification and they MUST leave the ring dismounted. If an animal gets loose from its handler whilst in the ring it will also result in disqualification.
- 4. Animals displaying continued disobedience may, at the discretion of the Judges, be disqualified.
- 5. Riders can be mounted or unmounted for the presentation of rosettes.
- 6.On Health and Safety grounds, all competitors must be in good general health and physically fit to take part.
- 7. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet current Safety Standards MUST be worn by all riders. Correct dress should be worn in all classes and further dictated by requirements of societies/organisations awarding qualifications in named classes.
- 8. Show Canes are not to exceed 75cms (30") in pony classes. Hunting crops are permissible. Bit-less bridles and running gags are not permitted unless otherwise stated in the class specific rules. Boots are not permitted in any classes. No bandages or protective pads on any animal's legs or feet are permissible in any class. See individual organisations rules for entry requirements pertaining to qualification classes.
- 9. Rosettes for those placed 1st 6th in all classes.
- 10. From our overall Championship event in October, trophies will be awarded to both the In Hand and Ridden Overall Champions and the In Hand and Ridden Reserve Champions. These will be presented at our Awards Evening on 2nd December 2023.

GFP Qualifier Criteria and Points Accumulation

Show Jumping

Those placed 1st - 3rd in each of the heights 40cm - 1m will qualify for the Grey Fern Park Show Jumping Championships being held on Sunday 22nd October 2023. Qualifying card to be issued and signed by the show secretary.

Dressage

Those attaining a score of 58% or over in Intro to Elementary will qualify for the Grey Fern Park Dressage Championships being held on Sunday 1st October 2023. Qualifying card to be issued and signed by the show secretary.

Showing

Those placed 1st - 3rd in each class will qualify for the Grey Fern Park Showing Championships being held on Sunday 15th October 2023. Qualifying card to be issued and signed by the show secretary.

Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. Classes may be divided according to entries.

2. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age. Classes may be divided according to entries.

3. EQUIFEST OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

18. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN HACKS

Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Small Hacks mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms. Riders any age.
- Large Hacks mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 154cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

19. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDING HORSES

Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

- Small Riding Horses mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.
- Large Riding Horses mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

20. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN COBS

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

- Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders any age.
- Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders any age.

21. EQUIFEST OPEN MAXI COBS

Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as a Cob. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders any age.

22. EQUIFEST OPEN RE-TRAINED RACE HORSE - NEW FOR 2023

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any height. Horses must have been raced in the GB to be eligible to compete.

24. OPEN RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE / PONY - NEW FOR 2023

Stallion, mare or gelding, 15 years old and over. Any type or breed. Rider any age. Classes may be divided according to entries.



25. EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships subject to their show rules & conditions. Classes may be divided according to entries.

26. EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship subject to their show rules & conditions. Classes may be divided according to entries.

27. EQUIFEST OPEN IN HAND RIDING PONIES

In hand Riding Ponies, stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age, not to exceed 153cms at maturity. Classes may be divided according to entries.

TGCA



TGCA Qualifying Class Sections - Traditional Gypsy Cobs - TOYS Best of Breed Finals. All classes are open to traditional gypsy cobs, which are of any colour and meet the TGCA breed standard.

Youngstock: Open to fillies, colts and geldings aged 1, 2 and 3 years old.

In Hand Senior: Open to mares, stallions and geldings aged 4 years and over.

Ridden: Open to mares, stallions and geldings aged 4 years and over. This class is split as per below:

Small - Not to exceed 148cm

Large - 148cm and above

No known breeding required to enter these classes. TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs.

Stallions - All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registrations and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

Quest for a Star Championship - Traditional Gypsy Cobs - 1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes above may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship as per below rule. ONLY CURRENT TGCA MEMBERS AND HORSE/PONY THAT IS ALREADY TGCA REGISTERED CAN EXHIBIT IN THIS CHAMPIONSHIP. Membership card and Members qualification card (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

- 7. No horse boxes or lorries to be mucked out in car park and all horse droppings must be placed in receptacles and areas provided.
- 8. Smoking is only permitted in the designated parking areas.
- 9. All children under 16 years of age must be supervised by a responsible adult.
- 10. All rubbish is to be placed in the bins provided.
- 11. Hard hats conforming to PAS015 (2011), ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards), or VG1 01.040 (2014-12) must be worn correctly whilst mounted. We recommend that approved body protectors are worn whilst mounted.
- 12. Permission must be sort for stallions to be entered into any classes and handlers must be 14 years of age or older. Appropriate ribbons worn in tail to indicate any horse that may require caution: Blue- Stallion Green- Inexperienced youngster Red-
- Kicker/Temperamental
- 13. No refunds will be given once classes have been entered unless cancelled by Grey Fern Park Equestrian Centre. We reserve the right to cancel or amend any classes or competitions as we see fit.
- 14. The judge's decision is final in all cases.
- 15. Persons who fail to comply with any of the terms and conditions, or any written notice, or verbal instruction given by an event organiser/steward may be asked to leave the Grey Fern Park Equestrian Centre without refund of any entry fees paid.
- 16. Anyone entering competitions or supporters will have deemed to have given their consent for photographs to be taken and subsequently displayed our website and other social media sites, unless we have been informed to the contrary.





Please remember your passports. The 6 month booster vaccination is not required. Your horse or pony will need to be fully vaccinated within the previous 12 months on the competition date. Please help GFP staff by picking up any poo and excess hay and straw from the bottom of your parking area. Please note the exit route from GFP. Pass the entry road and right turn at the willow tree.
